## Café Dix with a new look

Interior design by Kinzo and furniture by Objekte Unserer Tage (OUT)

Café Dix at the Berlinische Galerie has a completely fresh look for the first time in ten years. The new interior for the museum café has been designed by the architectural studio Kinzo and fitted out by the Berlin furniture brand Objekte Unserer Tage (OUT). The open structure of the 150m² space has been highlighted, revealing an unexpected airiness, flexibility and elegance.

The design is based on contrasting colours and materials: occasional walls of midnight blue set off the light synthetic surfaces of the counter and the tables of pale Smile Plastic, a robust material made from recycled waste. In the middle of the café, a long table stretches the full length of the room parallel to the bar. Other eye-catchers are the "OUT's SHULZ" bar stools in bright orange and the big illuminated DIX sculpture by nulight.

Kinzo, founded in Berlin in 2005, works at the interface between indoor architecture and design and has won an international reputation for its office interiors. The Berlin furniture brand Objekte Unserer Tage stands out for its hand-crafted furniture, made in Germany with sustainable production methods and fair conditions.

The furniture by OUT selected by Kinzo is also handmade. The chairs and tables can be arranged flexibly and accommodate 70 people.

Catering remains in the hands of Ibrahim Atoui, the proprietor of many years' standing. There is an oriental influence behind his seasonal menu of food prepared fresh every day. Café Dix re-opened on 17 March with a take-away service in keeping with the current rules.
