The video artists

Barbara Marcel and Ana Hupe

Barbara Marcel (*1985, Rio de Janeiro) is a Brazilian artist and filmmaker. She is interested in the connections between Germany and Latin America and works on social questions like growing environmental conflict and social inequality.

Ana Hupe (*1983, Rio de Janeiro) investigates hidden stories of resistance. Her installations are designed to challenge the images conveyed by colonial archives.

“Manioc, I grind you, sister” is a 2-channel video work created when the two artists worked together: one channel shows visual material and interviews with local activists and herbalists recorded between 2013 and 2017 in the Amazon region. The second channel juxtaposes historical and contemporary footage set to sound composed by



the musician Thelmo Cristovam: fragments from the film “No Paiz das Amazonas” (In the Land of the Amazon), Brazil 1922, by Silvino Santos and Agesislau de Araújo, and shots of present-day soy monocultures and local politicians.

The IBB Video Space at the Berlinische Galerie

The IBB Video Space presents artists who have caught the public eye with an innovative approach to film or video. The programme changes every month.

The Artist Talk will be in English. The films have English subtitles.
