The designs by these graduate students were inspired by a range of 20th-century artists and artworks. The presentation of 70 gowns by 22 designers will take place in the main stairway hall at the Berlinische Galerie, accompanied by a projection of drawings set to music.

The fashion master class is funded by the Senate Department for Integration, Labour and Social Services. It offers particularly talented graduates – currently 16 from two outgoing years – an opportunity to spend a year honing their personal styles and enhancing their knowledge of production techniques and business management. The course in fashion design, with its three sections fashion design | costume design | fashion media, attaches major importance to "thinking the craft of design through to the end".

Lette Verein Berlin is a foundation incorporated under public law. It was first set up in 1866 by Wilhelm Adolf Lette as an "association for the promotion of the female sex". Full-time training is provided for ten different professions at the college building on Viktoria-Luise-Platz.

### About the exhibition

Fashion and art are mirrors of social change and individual needs. The exhibition "Images in Fashion – Clothing in Art. Photography, Fine Arts, and Fashion since 1900" (until 30 May 2022) contains about 270 exhibits: fashion photographs, paintings and drawings, complemented by loans of selected garments, illustrating the role that fashion plays in self-expression and in representing its times.
